Utility Bills

Water and Sewer bills are due by the 15th of every month. Deposits are required and vary depending on the type of property. Payments can be made by mail, in person, and in our drop box. We accept cash, check, or money order. We cannot accept credit or debit cards. We also offer an ACH payment option where your payment can be directly debited from your bank account. Sign up for ACH payments in the Clerk's office. All utilities must be in the property owner's name unless both the property owner and tenant fill out and sign proper authorization allowing us to send the bill to the tenant. (Paperwork also located in the Clerk's office)

Trash Pickup

Garbage is picked up every Monday. All trash must be inside the required trash container provided to you. Please make sure your container is curbside by 6 a.m. The container must remain at the property if you decide to move. There is no monthly fee for trash pickup.

Recycling

Recycling is picked up every other week on the same day as your trash. During the months of May through August, it will be picked up every week. A separate container is provided to you and should also remain with the property. The Clerk's office has a recycling guide and calendar.

Large Item Pickup

Residents may place one large item per week for trash pickup. A reference guide is available in the Clerk's office showing what is or is not allowed. If anything is questionable, please contact Borden Waste-Away at 800-386-3313.

Yard Waste & Brush

The Street Department regularly picks up yard waste, such as grass clippings and leaves, as well as brush. Grass and leaves should be placed at the curb. Do not rake into the street! Please do not bag your yard waste, since we use a vacuum system for pickup. Brush and limbs can also be placed curbside for pickup. This is limited to 3' x 3' x 6' piles.
